Terms and conditions:-

1. Candidate / Applicant must be a citizen of India as define in Article 5 to 8 of the constitution of India.
2. Applicant who is already employed should submit their NOC from the respective authority/Officer concerned.
3. Candidate must not be less than 18 years or more than 38 years of age as on 01-01-2021. The upper age limit is relaxable up to 5 years in case of S.T./S.C. and 3 years for OBC as per Govt. Rule in force.
4. Application will be available online from midnight 25.02.21 to the midnight of 12.03.21.
5. The application must be accompanied by the following documents:
 - a. All certificate /mark sheets in support of education qualification along with age, cast certificate including valid employment registration card must be uploaded.
 - b. Scanned signature of candidate must be uploaded.
 - c. Recent passport size scanned copy of photograph must be affixed in the application form.
6. Candidate /applicant having qualification of Higher Secondary and above need not apply.
7. Valid contact numbers of the candidate should be clearly mentioned in the application form.
8. In complete application will be rejected without giving any intimation to candidate.
